- Usually: spend a term abroad in your 4th or 5th term abroad

Main selection round: 1st December to 15th January

Credit transfer options – general information



The options for credit transfer for ER 2015 and ER 2021 – combination(s) of all three options possible

1) Single course credit transfer

- Needs a pre-crediting process
- Contact: WiSo Credit Transfer Centre
- Please start pre-crediting process after you received the course list from your host school

2) Studies Abroad

- variety of courses can be used for studies abroad modules
- Contact for advising: ZIB WiSo, not Credit Transfer Centre
- Credits are increased: 5 ECTS at host school = 6 in Cologne/ 10 ECTS at host school= 12 ECTS in Cologne
- Check the Merkblatt zur Anrechnung (available <u>here</u>) for all information on credit transfer/ modules Studies Abroad

3) Studium Integrale

- Contact: ZIB WiSo
- Variety of courses can be used
- Credits are transferred 1:1 (no increase in credits)

For all three options: the grades will not be transfered







Funding



ERASMUS Mobility Grant

- Hosted by University of Colognes main International Office (Dezernat 9)
- you do not have to apply individually → if you are going to spend a term abroad at one partner school in the EU, you can receive ERASMUS funding
- all necessary information will come from the Dezernat 9 in due time

PROMOS scholarship

- PROMOS Scholarship available for applications for a term abroad outside the EU
- Is not guaranteed
- Also hosted by Dezernat 9
- Application deadline for fall: end of April
