

Two courses:

Criminal Behaviour (5.5 ECTS)

Advanced Sociological Theory (5.5 ECTS)

- Advanced Bachelor level
- Language of instruction: English
- Group discussions and presentations → active participation expected









Credit Transfer Options – Bachelor (ER 2015 & 2021)

Supplementary section:

- ER 2015: Studies Abroad in Social Sciences → 12 ECTS
- ER 2021: Studies Abroad I + II (SoWi) → 6 ECTS each

Course to course credit transfer:

- Criminal Behaviour: SM Seminar Handeln/Normen/Netzwerke → 6 ECTS
- Advanced Sociological Theory: SM Vertiefungsseminar Soziologie/ Sozialpsychologie → 6 ECTS

→ Only ECTS – no transfer of grades!









Credit Transfer Options – Master (ER 2021)

Social and Economic Psychology:

Supplementary section: Studies Abroad I + II (SoWi) → 6 ECTS each

Social Research:

- Supplementary section: Studies Abroad I + II (SoWi) → 6 ECTS each
- Course to course credit transfer:
 - Criminal Behaviour: SM Sociology Diversity, Cohesion and Conflicts in Societies and Organisations OR SM Special Aspects of Social Sciences
 - Advanced Sociological Theory: SM Advanced Sociological Theory and Research OR SM Special Aspects of Social Sciences

→ Only ECTS – no transfer of grades!









Application Documents

Three separate application documents:

1. Personal Data

- Letter of Motivation/study plan
- CV
- English certificate (WiSo Business English course, FILTERtest, TOEFL, IELTS or Cambridge Certificate,
 Master students: Bachelor's degree fully completed in English)

2. Study Details

- Current ToR from UoC
- Master students: Bachelor's degree, proof of enrolment

3. Master Students: Professional Data

- References for internships, extracurricular activites

Application Steps

- new WEX section: my applications/my personal data
- enter your personal data
- start your application
- select "Short Programme Sociology for Bachelor / Master"
- select Utrecht University
- start uploading your application documents (leave it open = don't submit)

Once submitted – no alterations possible!
