



Call for Proposals: Teaching in WiSo@London - Summer 2023

The Faculty of Management, Economics and Social Sciences of the University of Cologne is developing an **Academic Summer Programme** for Cologne Bachelor students in London (WiSo@London). We invite faculty members affiliated with an UK institution to join the programme in a teaching position for a 1/2-week course during the time of **mid-August – early September 2023**.

Location

WiSo@London will be held in rented facilities in a central location in London.

Teaching position

We invite lecturers with at least a Ph.D. degree and a scientific background in **Business Administration, Economics, Political Sciences, Sociology, Economics Psychology, or Business Psychology** to submit course proposals related to the following topics, with a specific UK focus:

- Post-Brexit Economy and Financial Markets, New Economic Routes
- Entrepreneurship, Innovation Management
- Economics and the Public Purpose
- Digital Finance, Fintech
- International Financial Management
- Doing Business in the UK (Skill Seminar)

or a related topic.

Course structure

We expect an interactive course where **Bachelor students** obtain theoretical knowledge about the subject, gain exposure to the world of practice, and apply general concepts to real-world situations. Group-work, case studies, and student presentations are welcomed aspects of the course.

Cologne students participating in WiSo@London may come from **different academic degree programmes** (Business Administration, Economics, Political Sciences and Sociology). Please apply an **interdisciplinary approach** when drafting your course proposal. Course participation will be limited to a **small group of students**, approx. 20 students.

The course needs to cover a total of **30 contact hours** (1 academic unit = min. 45 minutes), and provide an **overall workload of 180 h** (contact hours/attendance: 30 h and Independent Studies:150 h) for a **6 ECTS equivalent**.

Classes will be taught **on-block** for 5/6 days @ 5/6 academic units class time each day, preferably in the morning. We kindly ask you to provide us with **concrete dates of availability for August – September 2023** so we may plan and coordinate the course offerings in advance.



Application

Applications will be reviewed and evaluated on a rolling basis. Applicants will be notified by email about the acceptance of their proposal.

If you are interested in teaching a course as part of the WiSo@London programme during mid-August/early September 2023, please submit the following documents no later than **Monday, 31 October 2022**:

- Curriculum Vitae
- Faculty Application Data Form and Course Outline (see attached)
- Please include mandatory readings/cases in your proposal incl. approx. cost
- Dates of availability for mid-August/early September 2023
- Evaluation results if you have taught a similar course before

Employment

Faculty will receive a contract for the provision of services/ **contract as a freelance lecturer** from the University of Cologne.

Remuneration will be paid as a lump sum and is set for the following amounts:

- Full professor: 9.000 EUR
- Associate professor: 7.000 EUR
- Assistant professor: 5.000 EUR

Lecturers have to **organize transportation, board, and lodging in London** themselves and **cover their expenses**. Lecturers are responsible for paying taxes and contributions. Remuneration will be paid upon conclusion of the course.
